Applications are evaluated by a panel made up of kiteboarders SCKA Board members, and selected student(s) are awarded scholarships to support them in their goal to learn.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

General Scholarship - In 2019, a total of 1 x \$5000 USD will be awarded through general college-level scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Currently enrolled as a student in an accredited degree-granting program.
- Worked as a lifeguard in Los Angeles, Orange, or San Diego County.
- Did not receive a SCKA Student Scholarship in the last 2 years offered (*recipients from 2017, 2018 are not eligible*).

One application allows you to be considered for all available scholarships.

APPLICATION MATERIALS AND PROCESS - DUE OCTOBER 18, 2019

1. Short essay - Please provide an essay (around 400 words) on one of two subjects:
 - a) Tell us about your college degree plans and how the scholarship will assist you.
 - b) Describe your best day on the beach? What made it so special?
2. Redacted Pay Stub as proof of employment as a Lifeguard (cross out sensitive information).
3. Proof of enrollment to an accredited 2 or 4 year College.

Scholarship recipients agree to provide a short, detailed description about the benefit of the scholarship for use by SCKA in online and print media.
